Cardiac Monitors

This year's Capital Drive is all about our Cardiac Monitors. This February we placed four new Zoll Cardiac Monitors in service. The total cost of these monitors was just shy of \$140,000 with trade in of our old monitors. These monitors do more than just look at your heart. They will take your Blood Pressure, Pulse, Oxygen Saturation, Carbon Dioxide output readings.



They can let the crew members know how effective their compressions are during CPR. They will let them know if they are ventilating properly. They transmit 12 lead reading of your heart straight to the Emergency Room. All of this so that in those life and death situations you know you are getting the best care possible.
